



2019 CONFERENCE – GRADUATE STUDENT RESEARCH COMPETITION – AUTHORSHIP DECLARATION FORM

In order to be considered for the graduate student research competition, all authors listed on a submission must be graduate students at the time of the conference. Students wishing to participate in the competition should submit an abstract for an oral presentation following the guidelines found in the 2019 ASMA Conference call for submissions (<https://appliedsportmanagement.org/conference/>). In addition to the abstract submission, each student should complete the authorship declaration form below. Please submit the signed form to Dr. Wonyoung Kim (Wonyoung.Kim@wichita.edu). Three abstracts will be selected as finalists in the student research competition, with a winner determined following oral presentations at the conference. All three finalists will receive a \$100 conference stipend (the equivalent of registration cost), while the winner will receive an additional prize of \$200 and a plaque in recognition of the award (for submissions with multiple authors, the stipend/prize amount will be equally divided among all authors).
